Psalm 119:1-8

They do nothing wrong; they walk in God’s ways. You have ordained that your commands be diligently observed. May my ways be steadfast in the observance of your decrees. Then I will never be put to shame when I take note of all your precepts. I will praise you in sincerity of heart as I ponder your righteous judgments. I will observe your decrees; do not forsake me completely.
